5. Discuss the amendments in the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, dealing with time limit for arbitral award and the fast track procedure in order to achieve fast track arbitration.

6. What is a settlement awarded by an arbitral tribunal with the agreement of the parties in dispute? Discuss Supreme Court's power to enforce a settlement.

7. State the composition of the arbitral tribunal and explain the rules for the conduct of arbitral proceedings.

8. State the procedure for commencement of a conciliation proceedings. Highlight the differences between conciliation, arbitration, mediation, negotiation and judicial settlement.

9. Briefly discuss the background to the passing and the object of the Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987. Who are entitled to the legal services?

Discuss the organization, jurisdiction, powers and awards of the Lok Adalat. State the amendments of 2002 to the Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987 to enlarge the scope of the Lok Adalats.16
